**Reflection on the Eucharist (part 5)**

The whole of the *Torah* (Law) and the *Nevi'im* (Prophets) — the heart of the sacred scriptures for the people of the Old Covenant — is synthesised in one great, new commandment, given to every man and every woman by the Son of God: LOVE! *Love who? The Lord GOD!* The one who is our Creator and Father of life, also who is Jesus Christ, His only Son, also the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete. Love who else? **Each other**, our neighbours, but not just our wealthy or contented neighbours; rather we are commanded to love the poor, the stranger, the widow, the orphan — that is, every person who falls into the category of the “weak”, those who in a clear sense on the margins of the society, those who might be forgotten, who might be abandoned. We are not encouraged or urged to love them. We are COMMANDED to love them, to the same extent that we love ourselves. If we fill our own tummies, we must fill theirs in the same way. If we buy ourselves nice clothes, if we get ourselves all the best soaps and have the best gardens and houses and cars... Well, we can join the dots. This is not God spoiling our happiness. He is INCREASING our happiness in doing this! He wants the best for us, as He does for every brother and sister. And so, when Jesus leaves us the Blessed Eucharist, His most holy Body and precious Blood, this is not just something left over for us to cling to; it is His *best gift* to us, the gift of His very self. This is the fragrant offering that Jesus the Christ has given us in the offering of His own flesh and lifeblood. *Laus tibi, Domine Jesu Christe!* Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ! *Benedictus Deus in saecula!* Blessed be God for ever!
