## The Eucharist and All Saints

Already by AD 373, St Ephraem tells us that there was a feast kept in honour of “the martyrs of all the earth”. By the end of the 8th century in the Latin Church, a copy of Venerable Bede’s Martyrology says for 1 November: “The birth of St Caesarius and the feast of All Saints”. Who are these saints? They are the “men who seek your face, O Lord”. They are the ones dressed in white robes, “who have been through the great persecution”, whose robes have been washed white in the blood of the Lamb. These men and women have followed Christ to the Cross, and now into eternity. Holy Church knows them to be the “friends of God”, who have kept His Word, who have loved Him to the end, who have persevered — even though sinners like us — to the end of their earthly race. Happy and blessed are they all, for their faithfulness to God! Happy and blessed are WE when WE emulate them, when we seek His face each moment of our lives, when WE keep His commandments, when WE turn away from sin and are faithful to the Gospel.

The saints all loved the Most Blessed Eucharist! The Italian mystic St Gemma Galgani said: “There is a school in heaven, and there one has only to learn how to love. The school is the Cenacle. The Teacher is Jesus. The subject taught is His Flesh and His Blood”.
