Spreading the Truth:

Christ's mission is that of spreading the
Gospel, of taking the Good News to the very
ends of the earth, through the Apostles and
Christians of all times..

Let us ask ourselves whether, in our own
environment, in the place where we live and
work, we are being true transmitters of the
faith; whether we bring our friends to receive
the sacraments more frequently.

The apostolate that we carry out and that
attracts people to the Faith or to a greater
dedication to God, stems from the conviction
that we possess Truth and Love. The most
valuable treasure that we can give others is
faith in Jesus Christ and the life of grace. It is
an immense gift to have received the true
faith, but at the same time it is a huge
responsibility.

The apostolic zeal of the Christian who is
aware of the treasure he has received is love
for truth, consistency between one's thoughts
and one's life. It is to want souls to recognize
the richness that God has revealed, and for
them to be saved. In this endeavour of ours
to spread the Faith, whilst we treat everybody
with respect and consideration, it is useless to
transmit mere half-truths for fear that the
fullness of truth and the demands of an
authentic Christian life may clash with ways
of thinking currently in fashion, and with the
easy-going attitude of so many people. There
can be no half-measures where truth is
concerned, and love which is prepared to
make sacrifices cannot admit to settling for
less or be the object of compromise. We
cannot expect to please everybody by diluting
the claims of the gospel, so as to satisfy
conventional wisdom. **We speak**, St Paul
wrote to the Thessalonians, **not to please
men, but to please God**
