The Roots of Evil

God placed man above the rest of
creation to have dominion over all the
earth. God therefore endowed man
with intelligence and will, so that he
might freely give to his Creator a
glory far more excellent than that
offered to Him by any other creature.
God ordained furthermore that He
would raise man up so that he should
have a share in His own divine life
and should be able to penetrate in
some way His innermost mysteries.
This was endowment far greater than
anything that nature could provide.
God placed a single condition on man
: *of the tree of the knowledge of good
and evil you shall not eat, for in the
day that you eat of it you shall die.*
We know from Holy Scripture about
the sad transgression of this
commandment. Original sin,
personally committed by our first
parents at the beginning of history is
transmitted by means of generation to
every man who comes into this world.
Faith explains its origin, and we all
experience its consequences. The
solidarity of the grace that united all
men in Adam before the first
disobedience, turned into solidarity in
sin. To purify us of this rottenness, Jesus
willed to humble Himself in becoming
incarnate in the spotless womb of Our
Lady, His Mother. He spent thirty years
in obscurity working as any other man.
He then preached. He worked miracles ..
and we repaid Him with the Cross !
