Giving yourself to the service of God....

As St Alphonsus Liquori was torn between his professional career and the priesthood and fierce opposition from his father he finally decided to give himself to the service of God and neighbour in the Priesthood as so many religious do today. The religious life is a total sacrifice made giving up your life to God and being in total service to Him and the world. When touched by God and saying “Yes” to Him the road travelled may be difficult but the rewards are felt deep in one’s soul.

Following was written by Mother Elvira of the Comunita Cenacolo:

“Every day I am happier to exist, to have been born and even happier because the Lord has placed me in a position in life such that I can’t worry about myself. I’ve never had much time in life to think about myself, how I felt, if I was happy or sad, good or bad. I’ve always had to take care of others, and I realised that they were my human, Christian and religious advancement. For many years, I have been happily married to the Son of the carpenter of Nazareth, who Himself is a carpenter by profession.
