The First Miracle of Jesus

Mary is a mother who is more attentive to all our needs than any mother on earth ever has been or ever will be. The first miracle - water changing into wine in Cana takes place because Our Lady interceded.

Virgin Most Powerful – This name is given to our Mother Mary because her Son is God and cannot refuse her anything. She places herself between her Son and mankind in the reality of their wants, needs and sufferings. She puts herself 'in the middle', that is, as a mediatrix.

Our lives like the water in Cana, were flat and without the ferment of purpose until Jesus came to us. He transforms our work, our sorrows and our joys ; even death is different beside Christ

Jesus does not refuse us anything if it is according to His will. In particular does He grant us what we ask for through His Mother. She takes it upon herself to unravel our prayers if they are somewhat tangled up. He always grants us more than we ask for, as He did at the feast at Cana. An ordinary wine would have been enough, even one inferior to what had already been served, but He gave the Best Wine.

Do whatever He tells you – These are Our Lady's last words in today's Gospel. There could have been no better words nor more profitable advice.
