**CATHOLICISM!**

**The Catholicism Project**, with Fr Robert Barron (Word on Fire): *Episode 8* is **A vast company of witnesses: the Communion of Saints: Thursday 10 May**, at **6.45pm**. Bring and share your supper, and enjoy the company of other parishioners. We begin watching the DVD at 7.15pm. This week, the story of the Church is told in the example of those men and women who dedicated their lives to knowing and serving Jesus Christ. The Catholic faith is made visible in real human lives. The heroes of the faith whose lives we see tonight are: **Saint Thérèse of Lisieux** (the little flower), **Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross** (Jewish philosopher-convert Edith Stein), **Blessed Teresa of Calcutta** (Mother Teresa), **Dorothy Day**, founder of the Catholic Worker House.

**5th Sunday of Easter**

The vine is the Lord Jesus Christ; we are the living branches in that vine. This Vine is the model for the Church: without the vinedresser (the Father), and without Jesus (the vine), we are lost. They call us to make our home in them, but we are always free to turn away (*non serviam!*); this is the recipe for our spiritual ruin. The Church is the living vine, through whom we are united in the fulcrum of unity: the Apostle Peter and his successors. To remain united to the Vine is the guarantee of our deep, eternal happiness. Then the sap of God's grace flows through our being, giving life to every limb, every branch, to the greater glory of God (*ad maiorem Dei gloriam!*) Let us model our lives on the Blessed Virgin Mary's discipleship and faithfulness: strong, free, humble, her Immaculate Heart united always to the Sacred Heart of her Divine Son.
