**THE VIRTUE OF JUSTICE:**

Justice is the cardinal virtue which allows men to live together in a truly human manner. Without it, living together would be impossible. Justice regulates life in society taking human nature into account, that is, respecting the rights of the individual. How very sad it is to see that after so many centuries of men living side by side, there is still so much hate, so much destruction and so much fanaticism stored up in the eyes that do not want to see and in the hearts that do not want to love. Human lives treated as mere things, as statistics. How crucial it is for each member of society to work with personal responsibility for a more just, and healthier society. Our faith urges us on because the need for justice in the world is great. All the circumstances in which life places us bring a new message, asking us to respond with love and service to others. Love for Jesus Christ is the great motivating source of the just person's actions. Only with the light of faith can we appreciate what is at stake in the justice or injustice of our actions : it is a matter of accepting or of rejecting Christ Himself. Our Lord is in each person who is in need : if we are friends of Christ and love Him, that love and friendship will overflow into our relationship with others - the love of Christ urges us on beyond the demands of *simple* justice. In our dealings with others, Christ expects more of us. Out of love for Him and love for His fellowmen, Christians must strive to rectify unjust situations.  
Let us ask Him to give us a good heart, capable of having compassion for the pain of others. Only with such a heart can we realize that the true balm for suffering and anguish in this world is, love and charity.
