Learning to ask

Our Lord solemnly promises to be attentive to our requests. We should go to the Tabernacle exactly as the sick and the suffering used to go to Jesus. Humility is a prerequisite to confident conversation with God. We need to realise our limitations before we can appreciate how much we depend on our Father God.

The first things we should seek from Him are spiritual goods – the grace to love Him more each day and to have an authentic desire for sanctity. We should also ask God for material goods insofar as they serve to bring us closer to Him. These petitions can include good health, economic well-being, getting a job

God always wants what is best for us. Man's happiness, therefore, is always to be found in his full identification with the Divine Will. Even though what God wills may sometimes not seem so appealing from a human point of view, it necessarily leads to what is in our best interests. We have to want the Will of God : ***thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*** This is the best path to follow. It is the one prepared for us by the Lord.

Tell Him : Lord, I want nothing other than what You want. Even those things I am asking you for at present, if they take me an inch away from your Will, don't give them to me. If you don't want these things, why should I? You know best. Your will be done. Mother Mary will teach us how to be daring in our petitions.
