***The Fire of Divine Love .....***

The Lord wants the fire of His love to set  
alight our hearts, to light them up  
completely. He loves each one of us  
with a personal love, as if each one of us  
were the only object of His love. He has  
never ceased to love us, to help us, to  
protect us, to communicate with us ....  
even when we are ungrateful or when we  
sin, the Lord always shows forth His  
benevolence. God does not love us with  
a conditional love. He loves us totally  
with all His being, which is infinite. This  
mystery of love is particularly apparent in  
the case of His Mother, the Blessed  
Virgin. Mary, our Mother, is a mirror in  
which we should see ourselves. She  
lived a normal life – at the time of the  
Annunciation, she accepted God's eternal  
plan for her. How great was her faith!  
To think that she carried within her the  
salvation of Israel, the fulfilment of all  
the prophecies: She not only believed in  
God's absolute love, but believed without  
the slightest reservation. Mary teaches us  
to love God without limits.  
God loves me. This is the fundamental  
fact of my existence. Everything else  
pales in importance.  
We tell Jesus that He can count on us,  
upon our paltry strength and our meagre  
talents: Here I am Lord, because you  
have called me. And we ask our Blessed  
Lady to teach us to be courageous in  
leading others to her Son.
