***Magnanimity.....***

The Gospel of today's Mass invites us to be magnanimous, to have a big heart like the heart of Christ.

It exhorts us to bless those who curse us, to pray for those who persecute us. It calls upon us to do the good without expecting anything in return, to be merciful as '*your heavenly Father is merciful*', to pardon everyone, to be generous without measuring and calculating.

The virtue of magnanimity consists in the soul's willingness to undertake great things. It means greatness of Spirit and it gives us the energy to break out of ourselves and to be ready to undertake generous tasks that will be of benefit to all.

Generosity always leads people closer to God. It includes an unshakeable firmness of hope and the perfect peace of a fearless heart which does not bow down to man, but to God alone. We thus have total dedication to Christ, a dedication without measure, without conditions.

Christ is the light of the world, and so also, through His grace, is the Church by the Christian lives of her members. The Virgin Mary will give us this greatness of soul which she herself has lived in her relationship with God and with us human beings.

*'Give and it will be given to you'*

Jesus is present in our lives  
*'Father, faith in your word is the way to wisdom, and to ponder your divine plan is to grow in the truth'*
