to lose our fear of pain and tribulation, and unite ourselves to Him, as He waits for us on the Cross. We will never know how to love if we do not at the same time love sacrifice. Suffering, when seen in its true light, when it serves as a means of loving more, produces great peace and deep joy. That is why God often blesses us with the Cross. This is how we must travel along the way of self-giving : the Cross on our shoulders, a smile on our lips and light in our hearts. As Holy Week and Easter draw near, so do mercy, forgiveness, divine compassion and a superabundance of grace.

Let us cheerfully follow Jesus to Jerusalem, Calvary and to the Cross.
