Eagerness for justice and greater peace in the world

A loud clamour for justice can be heard throughout a large section of humanity, for a better-assured peace within an atmosphere of mutual respect between men, and between the peoples of the world. This desire to construct a more just world in which greater respect is given to man, who has been created by God in His image and likeness, is a fundamental part of the hunger and thirst for justice which must exist in the heart of a Christian. All of Jesus' preaching is a call to justice and to mercy. Today we unite ourselves to this desire for greater justice. We ask our Lord for greater justice and greater peace: we pray for our rulers, that they should be promoters of justice, peace, and a greater respect for the dignity of the person.

As well as what belongs strictly to the virtue of justice, we will practise those other manifestations of natural and supernatural virtues which complement and enrich it : loyalty, courtesy, cheerfulness... Above all, faith, which enables us to know the true value of the person, and charity, which leads us to go beyond what strict justice would demand in our dealings with others.

The ultimate solution for restoring and promoting justice at all levels lies in the heart of each man. It is in the heart that every type of injustice imaginable comes into existence, and it is there also that the possibility of straightening out all human relationships is conceived.

We see other people as children of God, as did Christ Himself, who says to us ***As you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me.***
