Palm Sunday –

Jesus makes His entry into Jerusalem as the Messiah upon a donkey, just as had been prophesied many centuries before. The people also acclaim Him in clearly messianic fashion. The Pharisees knew these prophecies very well, but so also did the common people, and they were visibly overjoyed. Jesus accepts this homage and tells the Pharisees, who were trying to dampen this demonstration of faith and joy, *I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out.*

The triumph of Jesus is a simple affair, He makes do with a poor animal for a throne. Jesus also wants to enter triumphantly into the lives of men today, riding upon a humble animal; He would like us to bear witness to Him in the simplicity of our work done well, showing forth our cheerfulness, our serenity and our sincere concern for others. He wants to be close to us through the circumstances of normal human dealings. On Palm Sunday our aspiration can be : *"I am like a little donkey before You. But You are always close to me. You have taken me by the bridle and brought me to do Your will .*

Jesus was ready to do everything for Jerusalem, but the city was not willing to open up her gates to His mercy.
